

# **ALBERTA GOOD SAM LADDER GOLF**

## **PROVINCIAL TOURNAMENT RULES**

- 1. This game uses only one ladder, placed in the middle. Toss lines on either side will be 15 feet from the ladder.**
- 2. Teams will be made up of two players. There will be one player from each team on either side of the ladder.**
- 3. A coin toss determines which team tosses first. This team will choose the color they throw. Players toss their bolas alternately.**
- 4. After both players have tossed their bolas, scoring is determined by the bolas that still hang from the rungs. Players can knock off bolas during the course of the game. Bolas knocked off during play do not count as points. Only bolas that are left hanging after all bolas are tossed are counted as points. Each teams' bolas will be recorded for each round.**
- 5. Points are determined by which rung the bola is wrapped around. The top rung is worth 3 points, the middle rung is worth 2 points and the bottom rung is worth 1 point. Bolas wrapped around the sides are not counted. A bonus of 1 point will be awarded if all three bolas are on the same rung. Example: If all three bolas are on the top rung, the score will be  $3 \times 3 = 9$  plus 1 bonus point equalling 10 points. The second rung would be 7 points and the bottom rung would be 4 points.**
- 6. Each player will throw five times, the scores being totalled and at the end, the highest scoring team moves to the right. Each team will play three games. The totals of those three scores will be the final total for the team.**
