

Official Bean Bag Baseball Rules

- The board must be 16 feet from the throw line.
- Teams will be selected from numbers drawn with the captain being the one drawing #1. A sign-up sheet helps determine how many boards will be required.
- There will be nine players on each team unless otherwise stipulated.
- Each game must have a scorekeeper and an umpire. The umpire's decision is final!!
- Each player will be given 3 beanbags to toss at the board. Each bag that does not go into a hole is a strike. Three outs comprise an inning for each team. When a bag goes into a hole, the runner gets what the hole states ie. Home run, 1 base, etc.
- Hangers will be removed by the umpire and counted as a strike except on the third toss. This will be considered a foul ball and may be thrown again until the player scores or strikes out. The opening in the lower part of the board is not counted as a foul ball.
- Bags that touch the ground first then go into a hole, do NOT count.
- Base runners must touch each base as they pass it. The runner must touch home base before the next player tosses or the **thrower is out.**
- If a runner goes to sit down without having touched all the bases and home plate, the run does not count.
- **Fault:** If a player steps over the throw line, that throw is void and considered a strike.
- The last player out will be the bag picker for the next inning. Bags should be picked up only after all three bags have been thrown.

- There will be 5 innings per game with a maximum of 5 runs per inning except in the last inning which has no limit on the number of runs scored. If the fifth run is a home run or any hit that drives home players on the bases, then all runs count.
- All innings must be played out, even if a team is winning with last bats.
- The winning team will advance and the losing team will remain. In the case of a tie, each captain will throw one bag to determine who advances. Points on this throw do not count towards the score.
- The tournament will consist of three games for each team. The winner will be the team with the highest cumulative points. Ties will be broken by the number of games won and lost. If there is still a tie, then there will be a count back ie. Who was winning after 2 games, etc.
- Last but not least: It is just a game!!! Have fun.
